### Maysan PRT invests in six Maysani courthouses to support electricity needs

AMARAH, IRAQ – Six districts in Maysan now have functioning generators to ensure continuous power for their courthouses thanks to the Iraqi-American partnership. The Maysan Provincial Reconstruction Team (PRT) invested a total of USD 280,750 on the main and district courthouses with the bulk of the investment in equipment.

“The American people have a deep respect for judicial systems and the PRT appreciates the challenges facing a community without dependable electricity to operate its courts system,” stated Maysan PRT Leader Gary Mignano. “Judge Ali Rasmy received this equipment, and his dedicated team of engineers has committed to ensure the generators will support the Maysani courts for the times to come.”

The six districts of Amarah, Majjar al Kabir, Kahlaa, Qalat Salih, Maymonah, and Ali al Garbi all received generators, which were installed by Iraqi contractor Tareeq Al Bayariq Company using local Maysani workers.

The Maysan PRT continues to work closely with provincial, district, and civil society leaders to promote capacity building in Maysan. The U.S. government has invested more than USD 360 million in the province since 2003, and there are currently USD 63 million in U.S.-funded projects underway in Maysan.

Security and project support for the Maysan PRT mission is provided by its military partner – 4th Brigade, 1st Armored Division – and supporting battalions.
